

TRANSPORT CHARGES &c. (MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS) ACT 1954

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Aldwark Bridge Toll LLP has applied to the Secretary of State for Transport for an Order to revise the charges for the use of Aldwark Bridge. The current proposed toll charges are set out in the Schedule below:

	CURRENT SCHEDULE	Current Toll
1.	Motorcycle with no more than 3 wheels	40p
2.	Passenger vehicle with an operating weight not exceeding 3,500 kilograms	40p
3.	Passenger or goods vehicle with a trailer or an operating weight exceeding 3,500 kilograms	£1.00

	PROPOSED SCHEDULE	Proposed Toll
1.	Motorcycle with no more than 3 wheels	50p
2.	Passenger vehicle with an operating weight not exceeding 3,500 kilograms	80p
3.	Passenger or goods vehicle with a trailer or an operating weight exceeding 3,500 kilograms	£1.50

Vehicles not specified above, with an operating weight not exceeding 3,500 kilograms, will be charged at the rate applicable for that of the nearest similar vehicle. Where a vehicle is drawing one or more trailers, in addition to the toll chargeable for the use by that vehicle of the ferry, there shall be payable for each trailer an additional toll equal to the toll for the drawing vehicle.
